Concerns over the signage of the new vape shop not being suitable for the conservation area. Ask for update on the waterfront space – this is ongoing. Meetings with council officials refused.

## Hermitage Primary PAL

Presentation by PAL (Parents for Active Learning) regarding the land ownership next to Hermitage Primary School. PAL are asking for support to stop the derelict land being turned into social and emergency housing, siting safety concerns and instead should be used to create a sports pitch which the school does not have. PAL shared their vision of what they want to see done with the land.

**Waterfront campaign** – Stop the supermarket campaign to save our waterfront fundraiser for court case is open and asking for donations. Judicial review will be heard 4 July 2025 at the Court of Sessions in Edinburgh. Legal reps are working on updated notes of argument and have received the corresponding notes of argument form the respondent's side.

Beach cleans at East Bay and the pier were well supported.

Thanks to the Colquhoun Pipe Band for playing in Colquhoun square every Wednesday evening in June, attracting large crowds.

Bus and coach parking – A&B Council and Helensburgh and Lomond Area Committee agreed to look at the parking provision on the waterfront and appointed Cllr. Fiona Howard to lead. Twinning signage – We were approached by the Thouars Twinning group to see what could be done to reinstate the twinning on the town signs, The cost of an additional sign below the current one is too expensive so the option of vinyl lettering has been proposed as a temporary solution. Leisure centre update – contractors appointed to completely replace the roof and fix internal damage by March. No mention of swimming facilities and the swimming clubs have had no response from A&B Council.

The Planning group would welcome more help with reviewing planning requests, and this invitation is extended to members of the community with relevant experience.

The Town Improvement group are looking for assistance in transporting equipment for the beach cleans. We also need more assistance with the shrub bed work on Colquhoun Square on the first Saturday of the month March to September 10am.
